How many siblings do you have?


I have three siblings.

In terms of emotional support they have supported me a lot because my mother's illness is not being easy and sometimes I get down, but thanks to them and some members this situation is more bearable.

The most memorable moment so far is the support received because of my mother's illness since the foundation helps mainly in the studies, but Mike and Maggie knowing this situation have helped me with money for medicine, transportation, and food something that I think not just anyone would do and that is why it has been a blessing to be part of DEOF.

I am currently completing the fifth semester of Psychology at the Polytechnic University Salesian of Ecuador. A subject that I loved despite the difficulty was Psychopathology, I learned many concepts and terms.

I am 21 years old, the most notable and painful thing that has happened during this time was losing my mother because of cancer, this happened when I was in the second semester and I thought about not continue my studies since my emotional situation was not the best. She says that her biggest dream was for her children to be professionals. The foundation has supported and encouraged me to continue.
